Cst DHILLON confronted the su. & was able to have the drug, which was for personal use, handed over)
Date	In file 92-5760, Cst DHILLON while on patrol, observed 3 males acting suspiciously outside a local bar. A closer look revealed one of the men holding on to a baggie of cannabis, which Cst DHILLON subsequently seized, with charges resulting.
Date	File 92/5622. Cst DHILLON has been doing foot patrols at night of an apartment block known to members for a variety of problems. He encountered a known drug dealer acting in a suspicious manner, with a subsequent search turning up enough LSD to support a possession for the purpose charge. Unfortunately, due to inexperience, Cst DHILLON did not lay the correct legal groundwork prior to the actual search and it's doubtful a charge will result. Nevertheless, this will come with experience & certainly the effort was there & the drugs are now in our hands.

On three separate incidents the Crisis Line called for assistance and we were met with a response which can only be described as excellent.


Both the Officers and the Dispatcher were very helpful, efficient, and acted with great diplomacy to our cries for help.
