That the arrest of Har Dyal, the Hindu editor and former lecturer on Indian philosophy at Stanford University, will be the subject of a Congressional inquiry is intimated in despatches from Washington received here yesterday. Friends of Har Dyal in Washington state their belief that his arrest was made at the ~~request~~ request of the British government and is part of the policy of the State Department to placate England. It is also stated that Hindus in British Columbia have raised \$800 to send here for the defence of Dyal. Meanwhile, Har Dyal is said to be translating his article on England and India from the page of his paper 'Revolution' in order to prove that the translation attached to the complaint against him, on the ~~stated~~ strength of which he was arrested, is misleading and erroneous.
