PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM

31 August 1914

His Majesty's Consul General at San Francisco will probably send you names of a large number of British Indians who have sailed from that port amongst whom there may be some of seditious or dangerous character who may be known to Mr. Hopkinson. Foreign Office have authorized direct communication to you from San Francisco instead of through me in order to save time and expense. Could Interior Department make necessary arrangements for informing India Office and Government of India of names of individuals suspected.
