Paraphrase of cypher telegram from Home Department
Delhi to the Governor General.

DELHI,

Delhi, 12 March 12th 1916.,

With reference to recent telegraphic correspondence on the subject of sending witness to Burma in regard to the case of Harnam Singh Hopkinson's letter of September 17th 1914 to the Minister of the Interior clearly states that he took with him two city detectives to search the store and house of Harnam Singh. Either of these would be competent to witness. In the same letter it is further stated that one Baboo actually pointed out Harnam's store and that Harnam's correspondence which we particularly wish to produce as evidence against him was found with Baboo's wife a white woman to whom it was made over by Harnam himself. This woman should be an excellent witness if disposed to give evidence. What we need from you is evidence to prove that correspondence in our hands is actually Harnam's. The internal evidence of the correspondence itself fully connects with Ghadr. Please telegraph early whether detective or baboo's wife or both are available. The possibility of using baboo himself might also be considered. Addressed to Canada repeated to Secretary of State.
