translation of a letter from
Nanak Singh to Duleep Singh.

9th April 1914.

Dear Brother,

I would just like to inform you that I am leaving
on the old man's boat (Gurdit Singh). About 150 men
have left Hong Kong, and about 200 from Shanghai.
I wrote this letter from Shanghai. Also fifty men
have come from Manila. The total is about 400.

There might be some from Yokohama. The boat
left on April 4th from Hong Kong and will
leave Shanghai on the 10th. Bhai Harnam
Singh is also with us.

Duleep Singh has left for Mexico.

I will be glad to see you. I am always thinking
of you.

We are having a pleasant time on board.
The Guru Granth Sahib (Sikh Bible) is also on
board. Services are held every day.

To Duleep Singh from Harnam Singh.

Dear Brother

I left on the old man's boat. About 150 men left Hong Kong.
The boat left on April 4th from Hong Kong arriving
at Shanghai on the 8th and will leave Shanghai on the
10th. There were about 200 came on board in Shanghai,
also there were some more coming from Manila. There
are about 400 men. Harnam Singh and Nanak
Singh are also with us. The money I asked for
you do not need to send.
