Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the men on the ship are getting rapidly ill, owing to their hunger strike and the medicines and medical comforts have run short.

I myself with my family cannot get anything to eat because there are no provisions on board and nobody is willing to cook for me too.

Under the above circumstances I am quite unable to look after the patients. Will you be so kind as to make the necessary arrangements for the medical attendance of 376 passengers of the s.s. Komagata Maru ?

I deem it necessary to ask you also the reasons that why I with my family am detained on board ship with others ?

I would rather like to point out as well that I am a Government servant holding a responsible post in His Majesty's Indian Army and so I dont see how you are applying the same laws in my case as in the case of Immigrants. Please excuse trouble and favour me with a reply at your earliest convenience.
