I beg to submit a report of the night watch for July 13th.

The swell in the Inlet became too rough to send small rowboat out in, so we patrolled with two men in boat belonging to WINAMAC.

While the Komogata was lying with port side toward North shore, we saw a very bright light placed out of one of the aft port holes, and as we were some distance from the boat, and not being seen, as it was a dark night, the light was kept going for at least an hour.

No Hindu reported on dock for duty, but it would have been impossible to have heard much with the high wind that blew.

Would like to requisition for another good pair of oars, if in case the heavier boat is used as two men were kept in it.
