Friends of India strongly protest against Mr. Stevens out  
rageous statements in regard to Sikhs and others. Over four  
thousand Chinese have paid tax in Victoria since April 1st as  
well as hundreds of Japanese. Sikhs are fully equal and we  
think far better citizens and spend their money here. It  
is true some have taken to drink. this caused by being debarred  
from home life. Great trouble will be caused in India if  
Canada continues her present policy towards them and allows  
Chinese and Japanese in such numbers.
