SIR:

I beg to advise you that Bela Singh, son of
Dunder Nath, of the Village of Jhona, in the District
and District of Northwales, India, arrived from this
port for Montreal on the 1st instant, per Pacific
Steamer Company, and he was furnished with a letter
of identification as per copy enclosed herewith.

As you are, of course, aware, Bela Singh was once
arrested and held in the late Inspector's custody in
his investigation work and was for a time in the service
of this Department.

I beg to quote below from a report furnished me by
Miss Catherine M. Dwyer of this staff, regarding a
request made by Bela Singh prior to leaving Canada:

"I beg to advise you that Bela Singh informs
me that Mr. Malcolm MacLeod has written to Messrs
Cory and Gillman and Mr. Stewart, asking them to
use their influence to get Bela Singh some sort of
government position in India, and also assist him in
other ways such as to get him immediately as far as possi-
ble from certain restrictions that are imposed upon
himself returning from the British Isles to their
homes in India."

"Bela Singh states he does not think it is fair
that Bela Singh should not have help out to himself
should he ever get a letter which will benefit him, and
that he is in some respect troubled, notwithstanding the
