Sir,

In reply to your letter of September 2nd, I have the honor to enclose you herewith for your information copies of certificates issued from this office to East Indians returning to India as a visit.

On the 25th inst. there is leaving the Port of San Francisco for the West Coast, there will be a large number of East Indians certified for India. Of this number, about 100 have booked their passage from Vancouver and Seattle.

A small percentage of these leaving this country have taken the trouble to register at this office, with the intention of returning to Canada.

I enclose below the names of those registered at this office, and enclose copies of the certificates issued with photographs and descriptions attached. There number 12 of which I would draw your attention to some viz:-
