Sir.

In continuation of my letter of the 16th inst. I beg to state that I called on the C.P.R. in connection with the intended immigration of Rindus to Danada. In an interview with Er. Brodie the A.G.P.A. he told me that he did not know of the proposed immigration but that he would look up the files in connection with this matter as he could not let me know definitely until he had been through the correspondence. In the meantime he saked me to call upon Mr. Baird of 541 Hastings Street Jest who would be in a better position to let me know about the matter in question. I called on Mr. Beird in the of Goe of the Columbia Frust Co. Ltd. at the above address and in an interview with him he stated that he had been approached for some months past by leaders of the Rindu Community in connection with the bringing out of Hindun from India to this Country. That in fartherence of this proposition and after looking into the gennineness of the intention of these people he approached Er. Foster of the J.P.R. on this question and learned from him that he would be willing to under take this sahese and that his Company would undertake the work if the whole thing was done in conformity with the present Conciden Immigration Aat.
