THE CAPTAIN,
S.S. KOMAGATA MARU
Vancouver

Dear Sir:-

We the members of the families of the passengers hereby advise you that you are an overboarder for the police, when you were asked yesterday, yesterday of yesterday checked our steamer last night at 1:30 A.M. They of our passengers have received various notices.

We have submitted to the police of that you may send the police to attack us.

Yesterday we addressed a letter to the British Consul through you, but sorry you did not bring the answer, in which we made all our requests.

We all are happy since three days and you today sent of this investigation and to take away the steamer, to kill us in the way and danger.

Last night when the police checked the steamer you did not come out of your cabin, though you were informed, which shows your complacency about passengers and your intention of killing us, but we were fortunate enough to save our lives, though the police fired their guns at us.

Perhaps you are right to take away the steamer finally without provisions and supplies.

There are more protests which you and investigation Agent say that they would supply the provisions etc. after 70 miles.
