Interview Date: November 1st, 2022

Q: What is your name now?
A: My name is Bant Singh Brar.
Q: What is your date of birth and place of birth?
A: I was born on April 2, 1946 in Dadarwala, Punjab, India.
Q: When did you immigrate to Canada?
A: August 21st, 1972.
Q: What is your immigration status now?
A: I'm a Canadian citizen.
Q: When you came to Canada what was your immigration status?
A: Immigrant.
Q: Family class, point system, how did you come here?
A: I was a visitor. I came here and applied for immigration.
Q: Father's name?
A: He.
Q: Before coming to Canada where did you live?
A: Sydney, Australia.
Q: Did you work before you came here?
A: I was a teacher in Sydney, Australia.
Q: Did you work in a mill or did you own a mill here?
A: I started mill right from the beginning and it was a really small operation.
Q: In what year?
A: I started in 88.
Q: What was the name of the mill?
A: Mission Shale and Shingle.
Q: Where was it?
A: Mission, it was situated in Mission on the river bank.
