Raghbir Singh Dhaliwal Transcription  
Interview Date: February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2005

- SD: Hello Uncle! What is your name?
- RJ: My name is Raghbir.
- SD: What is your date of birth?
- RJ: 1944, 27 February.
- SD: Ok and where were you born?
- RJ: India, in Punjab.
- SD: Where?
- RJ: Dhaliwal town.
- SD: When did you immigrate to Canada?
- RJ: I came to Canada in 1973.
- SD: Do you remember what month?
- RJ: 27<sup>th</sup> November.
- SD: At that time what was your immigration status? How did you come here?
- RJ: I came as a visitor.
- SD: When you applied for immigration, did you apply on the point system, family sponsorship?
- RJ: At that time immigration was free for everyone.
- SD: Ok. And when you arrived in Canada... actually before you arrived in Canada, where did you used to stay?
- RJ: In the pink.
- SD: In the pink. Did you work there or study there?
- RJ: I was working and studied a bit too, then I worked.
- SD: What did you study?
- RJ: Whatever they taught in the pink just like school here. English, Punjabi, Hindi, Math, Science. There were 4-5 subjects.
- SD: How old were you when you came to Canada?
- RJ: Four 26.
- SD: What kind of work did you do in India? Farm work.
