Meena: What is your name?
SB: Sukhwinder Singh Bolla
Meena: In what year were you born and where?
SB: 1965 – 1964, May 4, 1964 Punjab, Chokiana India
Meena: When did you immigrate to Canada?
SB: 1984, 2nd January
Meena: On January 2nd, 1984 you immigrated?
SB: Yes.
Meena: What is your status of immigration right now? Citizen, student, or immigrant?
SB: Citizen.

Meena: 5-6 years immigration?
SB: Yes.
Meena: Or irrigation, Agriculture?
SB: Agriculture, Agriculture.
Meena: Um... did you ever own or work in a mill?
SB: Yes.
Meena: What mill did you work at and at what date and for how long?
SB: The first mill was Mission Shake and Shingle. It used to be in Mission.
Meena: What was the name?
SB: Mission Shake and Shingle.
Meena: Shake and Shingle?
SB: Mission Shake and Shingle. That's the name of...

SB: ... the place.
Meena: Okay, and for how long did you work at Mission Shake and Shingle?
SB: I did... almost... 15 months.
Meena: 15 months?
SB: Yeah.
